PROJECTS

Mesa J Access Road and Warehouse Upgrades

Aug 2018 - Mar 2019

Access road cut to fill earthworks and culvert extensions to widen and upgrade deteriorating sections of the road followed by cement stabilisation, sealing, line-marking and signage installations all whilst maintaining and allowing continuous traffic flows. Warehouse works involved boxing-out unsuitable, hydro-excavation, installing electrical conduits and pits, importing basecourse and a combination of asphalt and sealing surface finishes.



51RD Rail Project

May 2018 - Dec 2018

Construction of 2.6km of new rail formation and rail access roads at the 7 Mile Rail Facility in Karratha. Works involved working alongside live operational rail with track protection measures in place to enable bulk earthworks, CSP and concrete culvert extensions, concrete rail cross-over demolition and replacement, importing suitable sub-ballast capping and basecourse materials, pavement preparation and laying 14/10 C320 bitumen spray seal.

Tom Price Stormwater Renewal Project

Nov 2017 - May 2018

Supply and installation of 1,300m of new RRJRC pipe and 80no. concrete pits at various locations throughout the town of Tom Price as part of the Shire of Ashburton's drainage renewals programme. Works included public notification/liasion, service locating and protection, removal and disposal of the existing redundant infrastructure, installation of new stormwater infrastructure and reinstatement of sealed roads, concrete kerbing and residential verges.

Design and Construction Mesa A Evaporation Ponds

January 2017 - July 2017

Early works consisted of the detailed design, site geotechnical and services investigation and reporting followed by a joint Client/Contractor design and safety review. The twin evaporation ponds construction included cut to fill earthworks, trench and surface preparation, geotextile and HDPE liner installation followed by security fencing of the site.

A new concrete drying slab was constructed along with new pipework and valves for the inflow to the ponds.

Marandoo Waste Fines Storage Facility Upgrades

December 2014 - February 2016

Bulk and detailed earthworks consisting of staged downstream embankment lifts of the tailings dam including modification and extensions, dismantling and reinstating of underdrainage equipment, placement of scour protection, waste fines and decant pipework removal and staged replacement.

Approximately 1.5 million cubes of material shifted in total.



Rail Capacity Enhancement Project - Cape Lambert

September 2013 - March 2015

Earthworks for new and existing level crossings and rail maintenance tracks including the supply installation of road furniture, sealing works and line marking. Supply and installation of passive level crossing gates and rail formation works.

70 Gate installations; 30 level crossings; 350,000 square metres of 2-coat seal.
